The Learning and Skills Act 2000 (Great Britain, 2000) sets out the provision for learners aged over 16 who are not in school The Act uses the term 'learning difficulties and/or disabilities' (LDD) rather than SEN The definition of LDD is essentially the same as for SEN, namely whether a learner has a significantly greater
